PHP Wind Farm Project Update

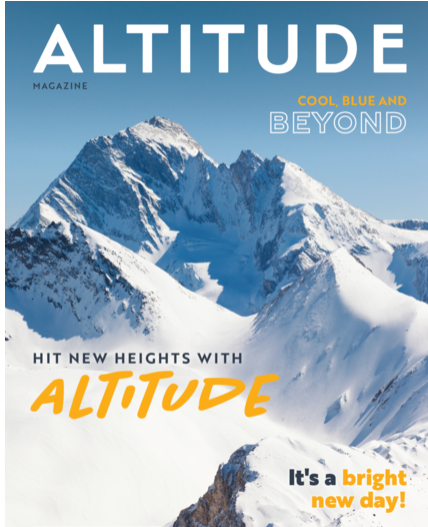
Port Hawkesbury Paper (PHP) is leading the way in clean energy by investing in new options for powering the mill and the Province.
