Economic Impact Study

Port Hawkesbury Paper (PHP) is the largest industrial employer in Cape Breton and is the leader in supercalendered paper manufacturing in North America. The mill manages over 510,000 hectares of Crown land and is a key economic engine and cornerstone of Inverness, Richmond and Guysborough counties. With over 325 direct full-time employees and nearly 900 indirect contracted full-time equivalent jobs, our business is integral to the economic success of the region – both directly through employment and through related businesses and services in the region.



Annual operating expenditures in the province equal about \$306 million. This spending triggers additional output in the rest of the Canada economy valued at an estimated \$84 million.



Tax revenues of all types, from both direct and spinoff activities, amount to approximately \$52 million annually. This includes personal income tax, taxes on products and production, and municipal taxes.



PHP generates approximately \$112 million in direct and indirect labor. This equates to an average of over \$79,000 per employee. 38% higher than the average wage in Nova Scotia.



PHP creates an estimated 1,200 full-time equivalent jobs in Nova Scotia, with 325 at the mill and another 900 contractors.


